1. **PUBLIC ACCESS.**
 - a. Public access is governed by the Otterburn Training Area Byelaws.
 - b. Outside the firing times listed above, and when NO RED flags or Lamps are displayed, public access to the ranges is permitted on specified TARMAC ROADS, the PUBLIC FOOTPATHS and BRIDLEWAYS (information is available in the Otterburn Training area Access Guide).
2. **ACCESS GUIDES.**
 - a. Otterburn Training Area and The Northumberland National Park publish an Access Guide. The Otterburn Training Area Access Guide shows the areas that are open to the public, during and after firing.
 - b. These guides are available from Northumberland National Park Centres, Information Points, Libraries, Tourist Information Centres, local shops and hostellers or downloaded from www.otterburnranges.co.uk.
3. **DRY TRAINING.** Be aware that outside published firing times; military units will be training, using only blank ammunition and pyrotechnics.
4. **SAFETY.** DO NOT PICK UP, KICK or REMOVE ANY OBJECT. DO NOT STRAY OFF THE PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY OR TARMAC ROADS.
5. **MOD RANGE ROADS** The MoD at Otterburn cannot guarantee that the roads/track on the Army Training Estate will be salted or cleared of snow during inclement weather.
