**Notice of Consultation:**

Regulation 28: Submission of Core Strategy and Development Policies Development Plan Document to the Secretary of State; and

Regulation 25: Pre submission consultation on Issues and Options for the Area Action Plan for the Otterburn Training Area.

Northumberland National Park Authority has submitted their Core Strategy and Development Policies to the Secretary of State. The Core Strategy and Development Policies sets out the overall spatial planning strategy for Northumberland National Park. It provides the basic principles and policies to guide development and the use of land.

In addition, the National Park Authority has prepared a consultation document setting out Issues and Options for the Area Action Plan for the Otterburn Training Area. It is intended that the Area Action Plan will provide a framework for the implementation of planning policies on the Training Area.
