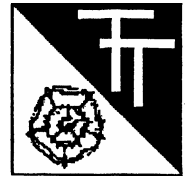




OTTERBURN TRAINING AREA MILITARY ACTIVITY FORECAST

1. PUBLIC ACCESS.

- a. Public access is governed by the Otterburn Training Area Byelaws.
- b. Outside the firing times listed above, and when NO RED flags or Lamps are displayed, public access to the ranges is permitted on specified TARMAC ROADS, the PUBLIC FOOTPATHS and BRIDLEWAYS (information is available in the Otterburn Training area Access Guide).

2. ACCESS GUIDES.

- a. Otterburn Training Area and The Northumberland National Park publish two Access Guides.
 - (1) The Otterburn Training Area Access Guide shows the areas that are open to the public, during and after firing.
 - (2) The Otterburn Training Area Upper Coquet Valley Guide is a detailed guide for the areas whose rights of way are permanently open to the public.
- b. These guides are available from Northumberland National Park Centres, Information Points, Libraries, Tourist Information Centres, local shops and hostels.

3. **DRY TRAINING.** Be aware that outside published firing times, military units will be training, using only blank ammunition and pyrotechnics.

4. **SAFETY. DO NOT PICK UP, KICK or REMOVE ANY OBJECT. DO NOT STRAY OFF THE PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY OR TARMAC ROADS.**

5. **FURTHER INFORMATION.** Cancellation of firing may take place after the publication of this notice.
