### **Position Statement on Mechanically Propelled Vehicles (mpvs)**

The Northumberland National Park and County Joint Local Access Forum position statement concerning mechanically propelled vehicles:

1. To endorse and to support the Northumberland County Council Rights of Way Improvement Plan policy EN15 as amplified in paragraphs 3.34 and 3.35 of the Rights of Way Improvement Plan.
2. To support the legal and sustainable use of mechanically propelled vehicles in a responsible and appropriate way.
3. To encourage Northumberland County Council and Northumberland National Park Authority to clarify and publicise the legal status of routes
4. To encourage mechanically propelled vehicle users to exercise their rights responsibly and without detriment to other legal users.
5. To support the use of Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) on routes which are being significantly damaged through irresponsible use by mechanically propelled vehicles.
6. To encourage co-operation between user groups, land owners / land managers and local communities to identify areas suitable for off road riding and driving.
7. To be aware of the need to ensure the protection of sites of nature conservation and cultural heritage importance (particularly designated sites- SSSIs, SACs, SPAs and priority habitats under the UK BAP and Scheduled Ancient monuments).
