ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

The National Park and Countryside Committee of Northumberland County Council (hereinafter called "the Committee") being the planning authority for the purposes of Section 87 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 in this matter HEREBY GIVE YOU NOTICE as the owner and occupier of land (hereinafter referred to as "the said land") known as Starmyres, Eldson in the District of Alnwick in the County of Northumberland and shown edged red on the plan attached hereto that:-

1. It appears to the Committee that there has been a breach of planning control after the end of 1963 in that the said land has been developed by the making of a material change in the use thereof for the purpose of stationing caravans without the grant of planning permission required in that behalf under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971
2. The Committee in pursuance of the powers contained in the said section 87 and considering it expedient to do so, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to all other material considerations HEREBY REQUIRE you within twenty-eight days of the date when this notice takes effect to take the following steps to remedy the said breach of planning control, namely:-
 - (i) to discontinue the use of the said land for the purpose of stationing caravans;
 - (ii) To restore the said land to its condition before the said development took place.

3. THIS NOTICE SHALL TAKE EFFECT, subject to the provisions of Section 88(3) of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 on the 3rd day of October, 1975.
