

## Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan

### Northumberland National Park Authority: Regulation 18 Decision Statement

Northumberland National Park Authority has considered the Report of the Independent Examination into the Submission Draft Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan received in March 2022. As required under paragraph 12 of Schedule 4B to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, the Authority considered the recommendations made by the Examiner and has made a decision on whether to accept or reject the recommendations. The Independent Examiner concluded that it would be necessary to modify each policy, to make modifications to the supporting text, including correcting typographical and grammatical errors, and to improve mapping of several policies.

The National Park Authority accepts these proposed modifications for the reasons given in the examination report.

The National Park Authority considers that the Plan, as modified, meets the basic conditions as set out in paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 4B to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and that the Plan complies with provisions made by or under sections 38A and 38B of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Accordingly, the Plan may proceed to referendum. The National Park Authority is satisfied that the referendum area shall be the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Area which comprises the civil parish of Haydon.

A referendum will be held as soon as reasonably practicable following the publication of this decision statement.
