### **Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan**

#### **Regulation 19 Decision Statement**

**Northumberland National Park Authority has resolved to ‘make’ the Haydon Neighbourhood Plan. The Haydon Neighbourhood Plan has been brought into legal force. It now forms part of the statutory Development Plan for the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Area which comprises the whole of the civil parish of Haydon. Decisions on planning applications must now be made in accordance with policies in the Haydon Neighbourhood Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.**

The Haydon Neighbourhood Plan was submitted to Northumberland County Council as lead Authority in November 2021. Publicity was undertaken in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. A report following Independent Examination of the Plan was received on 11 March 2022. This report found that, with some modifications, the Plan passed the necessary legal tests, and it could be put to local referendum. The National Park Authority accepted these modifications for the reasons set out in the Examiner’s Report. A local referendum was held in the Parish of Haydon on 30 June 2022. A majority of those voting were in favour of the Plan being used in making decisions on planning applications.

The Haydon Neighbourhood Plan, as modified following Independent Examination, complies with legal requirements governing the making of neighbourhood development plans set out in the Planning Acts and associated Regulations.

Accordingly, I hereby confirm that the Haydon Neighbourhood Plan has been made by resolution of the Northumberland National Park Authority meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Decisions on planning applications in the Haydon Neighbourhood Area must now be made in accordance with policies in the Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.
